Dynamic Paint Products Inc. proudly introduced the first paint roller made from the world's only polyester filament yarn originating from 100% post consumer plastic bottles - the Enviro-Roller™. The recycled fabric's superior performance characteristics make it particularly suitable for weaving into long lasting, lint free roller refills. Carefully winding the fabric on to 100% recycled plastic cores at our Mississauga manufacturing facilities has allowed us to create the Enviro-Roller™ – a true innovation whose time has come.

At Dynamic we are constantly exploring and implementing ideas that can make our full product offering and the way we do business “greener”. A cross functional “Environmental” Committee meets regularly to assess suggestions that can come from any of our employees, customers or stakeholders.

While recycling is becoming almost second nature, reducing our actual use is another priority. Take the saving of paper, for example: Our state-of-the-art warehouses in Mississauga, Ontario and Delta B.C. utilize paperless order picking. Invoicing from all carriers was converted from paper files to electronic summaries. In a typical example, the monthly invoices from just one transportation company were reduced from over 200 pages to four – and they didn't need to be mailed! All employees are actively encouraged to work with electronic reports on-line and sharing documents using “SharePoint” technology.

Wherever possible, we try to source recycled materials for our products – whether it be for tool handles, paint trays or our packaging materials. Our roller covers almost exclusively feature re-cycled plastic “cores.” Although this does impact colour consistency from one batch to the next – we still believe it is the right thing to do. And any end cuts created in our manufacturing process are returned to the same raw material supplier, where they are recycled once again!

Environmental concern has spurred us to reformulate or source alternatives to many of our vast product offering, including biologically-based cleaning, stripping and degreasing solutions. In fact, a number of innovative “greener” products are enjoying great success. At this year's Partners in Paintware Event we are featuring a selection of our Enviro-Paintware – a series of premium quality paint tools and accessories that are significantly more environmentally friendly than traditional products. Most are crafted out of recycled materials, are re-usable and / or recyclable. For example:

The Enviro Paint Brush™ is a quality brush that can be used, cleaned (actually more efficiently), and re-used like most other paint brushes. However, once it comes time to replace it, its unique design allows the user to change only the bristle refill. Saving the handle will typically reduce the amount of waste by over 50%. For painters who are concerned about the environment the Enviro Brush is a definite step in the right direction.

A sturdy paint tray – not just a tray liner – is made entirely of recycled P.E.T – from all of those soft drink and bottled water containers that end up in recycling bins.

We work closely with all of our supplier partners looking for efficiencies and ways to reduce waste. For example, the same company that drops off recycled pallets to our Mississauga facilities - which are used exclusively for shipments - also picks up cardboard and baled plastic for recycling along with any damaged skids being returned for repair.

While some of these efforts can cost more, other changes can result in significant cost savings. In one example, reducing one sheet of plastic from the pallet packing process cut huge amounts of plastic waste, and resulted in some very healthy savings; and the re-use, where practical, of corrugated packaging, has greatly reduced our cost as well as the amount of cardboard ending up in the recycling stream.
